Possible file formats: .pdf, .ai, .eps, .jpg, .tif, .psd

Used tools: Adobe Acrobat, Adobe Illustrator CC, Adobe Photoshop CC, Adobe InDesign CC.

All pictures must be provided in CMYK format or the colours might not be printed correctly.

Resolution must be 300dpi or higher.

Designs must be prepared on a scale of 1:1. All fonts have to be vectorised.

Signal colours and metallic colours are not possible due to the fact that we are printing with CMYK method.

Color must be specified in Pantone U solid uncoated or can alternatively be specified in RAL.

If no exact colour details are provided, a matt colour proof is required. Otherwise, the result may vary from the requested colour.

In the case of colour matching of a glossy surface (Digiproof, Pantone/RAL fans, pre-resin standard decors, ...), colour deviations and slight impairments of the printed image cannot be ruled out, as it is not technically possible to match these colours 100 %.

Red Line: File size

File size: Square tabletops must have plus 9cm added to the table size, round table tops plus 6cm added to the tablesize.

For example:

Tabletop 80x80cm = File size 89x89cmTabletop Ø 80cm = File size 86cm


The extra cm in the size are needed for the "nose" of the tables.


Blue Line: Table size

Green line: If you want a border, or a logo as big as possible on the surface, subtract minimum (!!!) 8cm from the tablesize (4cm on each side) to keep problems during the manufacturing away.

For example: A Maximum size on an 80x80cm is 72x72cm.

Coloured lines must not be in the finished design, these are just to help you with the design.
